10th Annual Clovis Ranch Rodeo, Saturday, April 10

(Clovis, California): The 10th Annual Clovis Ranch Rodeo will be held on Saturday, April 10 at the Clovis Rodeo grounds. The event is a competition between four-person teams of local cowboys and cowgirls. The best riders and their horses, compete against each other in the kind of ranching activities they must do every day on their working cattle ranch operations. Activities include rein work, cow work, trail, halter work, team roping, cutting and sorting. Events will begin at 8:30 a.m. and entrance is free for spectators. The Ranch Rodeo event continues a month long celebration of activities leading up to the 96th Annual Clovis Rodeo April 22-25, 2010.

Cowboys and cowgirls from throughout the Central Valley will be competing for more than \$16,000 in prizes including custom made saddles and silver bits. The 2009 championship team of John Smith, Carl Gould, Bill Garlic and Buster Berna will be returning to defend their title and their luck at winning a third championship saddle at the event. Tim Burk and his two-time championship team from Squaw Valley will be ready to compete Saturday and their luck at a coveted third championship saddle. There will also be two new cowgirl teams competing for the first time in Clovis. Ranch Rodeo teams are required to compete in five judged and six timed events. The events include team branding, team doctoring, individual ranch horse, individual trail horse, ranch cutting, team roping and team sorting. Each team consists of four (4) riders who must use their same horse for the entire event.

The Clovis Rodeo will open on Thursday, April 22 with the return of the PBR Bull Riding Touring Pro-Division. Friday night rodeo action will be followed by a concert for rodeo fans by rising country superstar, Jake Owen. Two days of rodeo activities continue through the weekend, along with the popular Clovis Rodeo parade on Saturday, April 24.
