David Kennedy Wins Clovis Rodeo's PBR on Juicy Vindication 97th Annual Clovis Rodeo Continues through April 24

(Clovis, California): David Kennedy took home the championship of Clovis Rodeo's PBR tonight on his bull Juicy Vindication with an 85 point ride; the bull was supplied by stock contractor Don Kish. The only rider tonight to have a score on both rides, Kennedy's wild ride on Check Mate in round one earned him an 83 and took him to his final winning round.

The roster of bull riders who competed at Clovis included the top names in the sport of professional bull riding's current standings, including Ben Jones, JB Mauney, Shane Proctor, Pete Farley, Brian Canter, Ross Coleman. Bull rider Cord McCoy, a fan favorite who is known to crowds for his competition on CBS television's *Amazing Race*.

A nearly capacity crowd attended the Clovis Rodeo's opening night with the PBR Touring Pro-Division. The day began with a blood drive benefiting the Central California Blood Center with more than 1,011 pints of blood donated by the community.

Three more days of rodeo action are scheduled to continue through Sunday, April 24. PRCA Rodeo action with World Champion cowboys and up and coming cowboys begins tomorrow night at 5:30 p.m. followed by a concert with Easton Corbin. The excitement of the Clovis Rodeo continues through the weekend, along with the popular Clovis Rodeo parade on Saturday, April 23.
