## Clovis Rodeo Ticket Office Opens Today

*Celebrate An American Cowboy Tradition with the 100<sup>th</sup> Clovis Rodeo April 24-27, 2014*

**(Clovis, California):** Ticket sales for the 100<sup>th</sup> Clovis Rodeo continue today with the opening of the ticket office at the Clovis Rodeo Grounds. Tickets have been on sale since January 9 on-line but today marks the opening of the ticket office for rodeo fans who prefer to buy tickets in person. The 100<sup>th</sup> Clovis Rodeo takes place April 24-27, 2014 with four-days of hoof pounding rodeo action and back to back concerts from some of Country Music's newest rising stars. American Idol's Scotty McCreery is set to perform Thursday, April 24 followed by one of Country Music's newest chart climber, Tyler Farr on Friday, April 25.

The box office located at the Clovis Rodeo Grounds at 748 Rodeo Drive, south of Fifth Street, just off of Clovis Avenue opens today. Fans can buy tickets in-person 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. daily Monday through Friday. Box office hours will be extended in April.

The Clovis Rodeo will include back to back concerts for rodeo fans attending the Thursday and Friday night performances. Immediately following the opening of the 100<sup>th</sup> Clovis Rodeo and the PBR Bull Riding Touring Pro Division on Thursday, April 24 will be a concert with American Idol Season Ten Winner, Scotty McCreery. Friday will kick off with PRCA professional rodeo action followed by a concert with rising country star Tyler Farr, who wanted to create a debut album that could be taken anywhere from the open road to a barn party.

The concerts on Thursday and Friday nights will immediately follow the rodeo performances. Fans can continue to purchase tickets for all performances of the 100<sup>th</sup> Annual Clovis Rodeo scheduled to run April 24-27, 2014 by visiting the ticket office at the rodeo grounds, calling 559-299-5203 or at [www.clovisrodeo.com](http://www.clovisrodeo.com). A Thursday and Friday ticket combo package is available this year for \$50; giving fans a five dollar savings. Tickets range in price from \$20 - \$30 and are reserved seating only for all performances.

The 100<sup>th</sup> Clovis Rodeo opens on Thursday, April 24 with the return of one of the best shows on dirt, the PBR Bull Riding Touring Pro-Division, and some of the rankest bulls and toughest cowboys in bull riding. Three days of heart stopping rodeo action follow along with the popular Clovis Rodeo parade on Saturday, April 26. The Clovis Rodeo runs April 24-27.
