Multi-Platinum Country Group LONESTAR Will Perform At 95th Clovis Rodeo Friday, April 24, 2009

(Clovis, California): Multi-platinum country music group, LONESTAR, is scheduled to perform at the 95th Clovis Rodeo on Friday, April 24, 2009. A \$20.00 general admission ticket gets fans both the rodeo and a concert Friday evening.

LONESTAR is a multi-platinum country music group who has a musical legacy tied to modern-day classics like "Amazed," "I'm Already There" and "My Front Porch." A recently released single "Let Me Love You" continues to climb the country music charts. With 10 number one hits under their belt, founding members, Dean Sams and Michael Britt are joined by their new lead singer, Keech Rainwater and veteran Cody Collins on the road for the Clovis Rodeo performance. The Clovis Rodeo is joined in hosting the annual country concert following Friday night rodeo with KISS Country 93.7 FM radio.
