Professional Bull Riding Invades Clovis, California on April 23

Clovis Rodeo, April 23 - 26, 2009

(Clovis, California): 40 of Professional Bull Riding's rising stars of the sport will buck, their way into Clovis, California next week. The USST PBR Bull Riding Challenger Tour will make its return and bring some of the rankest bulls, highest scores and biggest wrecks to the Clovis Rodeo on Thursday, April 23 at 7:00 p.m.

The Challenger tour features the PBR's rising stars that are one step away from competing in the Built Ford Tough PBR Tour and World Finals presented by Wrangler in November 2009.

Two lucky fans in attendance at the Clovis Rodeo on Thursday, April 23 will also receive tickets to the PBR finals at the Thomas and Mack Center in Las Vegas in November 2009.
